

Prototype

- Built 1870's from Wilmington, DE to Reading, PA
- Leased by P&R in 1895 and purchased in 1900
 - Model 1900-1905
- Major commodities were coal, iron and steel, stone and lumber
 - Port of Wilmington
 - Steel mills & foundries
 - Quarries
 - 5 PRR and 1 B&O interchange
- 1895 Prototype had about 30 engines
 - 8 psgr trains/day, average 3 cars each
 - 14 frt trains/day, average 25 cars each




Layout

- 24x24 room
- HO scale
- Code 55 and 70 handlaid track
 - #4, 5, 6 switches (about 95 built so far)
 - Pushrod switch controls
- 24" min radius, 27" Std radius
- 2% max grade
- NCE DCC
 - Tethered yard throttles
 - Radio road jobs



Layout

- Phase 1 : Wilmington to Coatesville
 - DRE Branch
 - Kentmere Branch (via helix)
 - 80 ft main
 - Started 2015, in service 2017
- Phase 2 : Coatesville to Birdsboro
 - French Creek branch (via helix)
 - Reading Outer Station (via Helix)
 - 45 ft of main
 - Started 2019, est. in service 2021



Layout

- 14 active engines
 - 4 Mantua 0-6-0 camelbacks
 - 6 Roundhouse 2-8-0
 - 1- Roundhouse 4-4-0
 - 2 Bachmann 4-6-0
 - 1 Bachmann 4-4-0
- 213 cars
 - 16 scratchbuilt
 - 27 resin and wood kits
 - 96 kitbashed
 - 74 plastic kits or RTR
